Re-interview of Mrs. Viola Owens, of 16, Burdette St. Greenville, S.C.

Description of person she stated she saw yesterday at sign for Looper's Garage: B/M--late teens or early 20s. Blue jean pants and white shirt. She stated that she never saw the subject full in the face but did see a right profile of his face and the back of his head. Stated the subject was running when she saw him, toward old ice plant on Pendelton st.

Mrs. Owens further stated that a noise attracted her attention, that she was not looking in the direction of Looper's Garage until she heard a noise and at that time saw a subject at or near the sign. Stated that she did not see the subject hit the sign. She also stated that between the arrival time of Norris Ambulance and the time she had seen the subject was about 5 minutes. (Time exact unknown to Mrs. Owens.)

Mrs. Owens also stated that prior to hearing the noise and seeing the running subject that two (2) Semis (Tractor- Trailers) had just gone toward West Greenville on Pendelton st. She also stated that traffic was heavy on Pendelton st. going toward West Greenville.

The sign in question is made of some type particle board or wood and sound does not seem loud when sign is struck. The poles supporting said sign are metal and when struck with metal object the sound is louder but the sound does not travel very far.
