I have not been threatened or promised any reward to make this statement and do so voluntarily. I understand I have the right to stop at any time. I hereby waive these rights.

I was coming out of Mason St. on to Pendleton St. at the stop sign when I saw a black male running up the street from the direction of Looper garage on the same side. The black male turned up between the old ice plant and a old service station. When I got on Pendleton St headed toward town I saw him again he was getting close to halfway through the open area behind the building. I went on up town and paid some bills. About 45 mins. had past when I got back to the area and found out what was going on. The boy I saw running had on dark cloths and I did not see him in the front.
