While on routine patrol tonight, 01-05-75 at approximately 01:00 hours we, officers Davis, J. W. and Dye, J. L. were approached by a white male on Lois Ave. who stated that he had some information that may be helpful in the Looper murder case.

He stated that about a week before the murder occurred, he was told by a Edwards, Steve that he over heard a statement made by Outz, Anthony that a HIT MAN was in town to rub out a narcotic agent. He stated that knowing Edwards, he dismissed the statement at that time.

The informer stated that he had a place in the vicinity of Fair Play and traveled to and from quite a bit. Stated that he passed Grandland Cemetery Monday and remarked that it must be a large funeral. Edwards was with him and stated, no, its two funerals and one service. That the Looper had been murdered. He then remembered the statement told to him earlier about the hit man being in town.

He stated that the car used by this man was believed to be a white over red caddillac and it was at Adams' Junk Yard. He stated that Outz, had been busted on a narcotic charge and this may be the information needed. He did not want to become involved in this matter unless he had to. If so he would. He left it at that, not asking him his name. While talking he stated that he lived at 19 Broadway Ave. Greenville. His Lic. No. is EWE 184.
